Why BTM? ICT Talent Shortage

Demand side issues

- Shortage business/ICT skills (25%+ of the labour market) across all sectors
 - 200,000+ are already employed in BTM jobs – twice as many as 10 years ago – and demand continues to grow.
 - Employers will need to fill more than 50,000 BTM-related jobs in the next few years.



Why BTM? ICT Talent Shortage

Supply-side challenges


- ICT enrollments low


Make BTM the most educated, capable, and recognized profession in the world.


